A NON CONFORMANCE

We note that your gas installation, while working safely when inspected, does not conform to the safety requirements of the current Irish Standard I.S. 813 Domestic Gas Installations, I.S. 820 / Non-Domestic gas installations and/or I.S. EN 1949 specification for the installation of LPG systems for habitation purposes in leisure accommodation vehicles and accommodation purpose in other vehicles.

BC HAZARD

Your gas supply/appliance has been disconnected for the safety reason/s highlighted overleaf. The gas supply/appliance shall only be restored by a **Registered Gas Installer (RGI)**. This ensures that the **HAZARD** is rectified to the to the Irish Standard I.S. 813, I.S. 820 or I.S. EN 1949.

WHAT TO DO NEXT

To ensure that your Gas Supplier can continue to supply gas, we advise that you should engage a **Registered Gas Installer (RGI)** to make sure that the defects on your gas installation are rectified immediately. <u>Always request to see Registered Gas Installers (RGI)</u> identification card prior to gas work commencing. When all gas works are complete ensure you receive a Declaration of Conformance Certificate (Completion Cert.) from the Registered Gas Installer (RGI).

NOTE:

- (1) Under no circumstances should you attempt to restore or allow any person, other than a Registered Gas Installer (RGI), to restore the gas supply, as doing so may endanger you or other person and/or property.
- (2) By law only Registered Gas Installers (RGI) are the only personnel authorised to restore your gas supply under the Energy (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2006.
- (3) The absence of a valid Declaration of Conformance Certificate being available to your Gas Supplier for inspection, or the unauthorised restoration of the gas supply may result in your gas being disconnected (Article 12, Gas (amendment) Act 1987 (Section 2) Order, 1987 and 2003).

This notice is issued to you in the interest of your safety and as a reminder that it is the Homeowner/Landlords responsibility to ensure that the Gas appliances and installation in your premises are safely maintained.

REMEMBER ALWAYS USE A REGISTERED GAS INSTALLER (RGI)

MINIMUM REQUIRED FOR SAFETY UNLOCK / RESTORATION OF GAS SUPPLY.

Annex E I.S. 813 scope of safety inspection (minimum);

- 1. Soundness of the installation and connected appliances;
- 2. Visible condition of accessible gas pipework and flexible connections;
- 3. Adequacy of fixed air supply;
- 4. Effectiveness of any flue or chimney and
- 5. Appropriateness of appliance location.

Registered Gas Installers (RGI) <u>may</u> restore gas to a gas installation following a "Safety Isolation" (i.e. after rectification of the Hazard) by the following procedure below:

- 1. Refer to the Notification of Hazard issued to the customer and complete repair works on the installation.
- Carry out a full inspection on the installation and the associated appliances (minimum Annex E as above). This will include a Soundness Test at operating pressure. If the pipework has been altered refer to clause 13.2 of I.S. 813 for test procedure.
- 3. Note: When carrying out the Soundness Test that a sealing disc may be fitted on the meter (if fitted).
- 4. The gas supply may be restored by one of the following means depending on the safety isolation in place:
 - a) Unlock the clamp on the meter isolation value;
 - b) Remove cap on inlet pipework to the meter;
 - c) Remove Meter Sealing Disc on the outlet of the meter. Note only one meter washer must be used to seal the connection.
- 5. Commission all appliances on completition of Annex E check.
- Ensure that no "Recalled Appliances" are connected (Refer to Recalled Appliances Technical Bulletin available from RGII, Tel: (01) 499 7998 or download from www.rgii.ie).
- 7. Complete the Declaration of Conformance Certificate. Issue white copy to the customer.
- 8. Contact Bord Gáis Networks on 1850 211 540 / Gas Supplier (LPG)to report the completion of gas restoration works. You will be asked to provide the Declaration of Conformance Certificate number and the meter reading (if fitted). Call staff are available from 8am to 8pm, Monday to Friday and from 9am to 5.30pm on Saturdays. If works take place outside these hours contact Bord Gáis Networks / Gas Supplier (LPG) with the details at the earliest opportunity.
- Remove the Safety Isolation Warning label (if fitted) and attach to the green copy of the Declaration of Conformance. The Label and Declaration must be returned together as soon as possible (but no later than 10 working days) to:
