- 1. Install gas equipment and appliances safely.
- 2. Obtain GI 1 & GI D Certificates that meet the required standards.
- 3. Be able to apply for registration on "The Register Of Gas Installers" for use by the gas industry.

Course Objectives for Gas Installer 1 Safety (GI1)

On completion of this course the craftsperson will have acquired the knowledge and skills to enable them to work safely at domestic and non-domestic gas installations under supervision having passed the course test.

Course Objectives for Gas Installer Domestic (GID)

On completion of this course the craftsperson will have acquired the knowledge and skills to enable them to install and admit gas safely to domestic gas installations having passed the in-course assessments and end of course tests.
